Chimichurri Steak Skewers:

(Makes about 16-20 mini skewers)

Chimichurri Sauce:

2 cups fresh Italian parsley

4 tablespoons fresh oregano

½ cup fresh cilantro

3 garlic cloves, peeled

1 shallot, halved

1 cup olive oil

1 small jalapeño pepper, quartered

½ cup red wine vinegar

¼ teaspoon dried crushed red pepper

3 tablespoons fresh lemon juice

½ teaspoon salt

½ teaspoon black pepper

Steak Skewers:

1 ½ pounds top sirloin steak, cut into 1-inch cubes

¼ teaspoon salt

¼ teaspoon black pepper

Mini skewers soaked for 30 minutes

Before grilling:

In a large blender or food processor, combine all the chimichurri ingredients and puree until smooth.

In a large bowl, combine the steak cubes with salt, pepper and 1 cup of the chimichurri sauce.

(Reserve the remaining sauce in a separate bowl for dipping.)

Toss the beef cubes with the sauce to cover well. Cover the marinating steak pieces and let stand at room temperature for at least 30 minutes.

Meanwhile, submerge the skewers in water to soak.

Skewer three steak bites onto each of the small skewers. Grill for 2-3 minutes on each side until the internal temperature reaches 145F.

Serve the grilled mini skewers with a generous drizzle of the reserved chimichurri sauce.

Spaghetti with Fresh Clams:

Ingredients:

- 1 pound of spaghetti
- 2 pounds of clams
- 6 garlic cloves (halved)
- 15 to 20 grape or cherry tomatoes (seeded)
- Fresh Parsley
- 6 Tablespoons Extra Virgin Olive Oil
- Salt for boiling water
- 2 cups of water

Directions:

Rinse the clams under cold water to remove any sand. In a large pot, add 2 cups of water, clams, and fresh parsley. Steam until all the clams open. Discard any unopened clams. Remove clams and reserve the clam broth for spaghetti.

In a large sauté pan, add 6 Tablespoons of Extra Virgin Olive Oil and the halved garlic cloves. Sauté garlic until golden brown, then remove garlic.

Add the clams and toss for several minutes. Cut the cherry tomatoes in half and remove any seeds.

Add the tomatoes, and reserved clam broth to the p

Add the tomatoes, and reserved clam broth to the pan and toss. Add fresh parsley to taste.

While you are doing the above, bring a pot of water to a boil. Once the water is boiling add salt to keep pasta from sticking together. Add spaghetti and cook to desired tenderness. Reserve some pasta water should the spaghetti be too dry.

Put drained spaghetti into a large pasta bowl, then add clams, broth, and toss. You can also add additional olive oil directly to the tossed mixture if too dry.

Spaghetti with Canned Clams:

Ingredients:

- 1 can of Progresso White Clam Sauce
- 1 Can of Geisha Whole Baby Clams
- 4 Garlic Cloves, minced
- 2 Tablespoons of Olive Oil
- Crushed Red Pepper optional

Directions:

Sauté minced garlic in olive oil until you smell a nice aroma. Add the entire contents of both cans and stir. Add crushed pepper to add heat. Cook over medium heat for several minutes.

Cook spaghetti to desired tenderness. Ladle mixture over spaghetti. Add grated cheese and enjoy.
