Creamed New Potatoes:

INGREDIENTS:

- 2 lbs. red-new potatoes
- 2 tablespoon unsalted butter
- 1 tablespoon all-purpose flour
- 1 cup whole milk
- ¼ teaspoon black
- 1/2 teaspoon kosher salt
- 2 tablespoon chopped fresh chives

DIRECTIONS:

Place potatoes in a large saucepan, cover with salted cold water by 1-inch, bring to a boil over high heat.

Reduce heat to medium; simmer until potatoes are tender; about 15 minutes. Drain.

Add butter to saucepan and melt over medium. Whisk in flour; cook, whisking constantly, 1 minute. Gradually whisk in milk. Bring to a boil over medium heat, whisking occasionally, until slightly thickened, about 2 minutes. Stir in pepper and salt. Add potatoes.

Cook, stirring constantly, until potatoes start to break apart and mixture is thickened, about 2 min. Sprinkle with chives

- ¹/₂ cup dark brown sugar
- ¹/₂ cup light brown sugar
- 1 egg yolk
- 2 cups flour
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- Pinch of salt
- 1-12 oz. pkg chocolate chips, melted
- 1 cup pecans, chopped

DIRECTIONS:

Cream butter and sugar, beat in egg yolk. Blend in flour, add vanilla and salt, press into a 9 x 13 pan. Bake at 350 for 15 minutes. Remove from oven, spread with melted chocolate, sprinkle with pecans, cool, break into cookie size pieces. Submitted by Kenn Burkhead

Pedestrian hit/run Incident:

On Wednesday, January 12th, at approximately 3:30 to 4:00 p.m., a Springwood apartment resident was hit by a white vehicle going into Springwood Villas II community. The woman was knocked off her tricycle while crossing Springwood Blvd. with her dog. The driver of the vehicle didn't even have the courtesy to stop to see if the woman needed medical assistance, just kept on driving. This is not the first incident of bicyclists being hit by a car in Springwood II.

How to prevent this from happening again:

Drivers need to slow down and follow the 15-mph speed limit and come to a full stop at stop signs before proceeding.

If you think the pedestrian/cyclist isn't paying attention, proceed slowly and tap gently on your horn to let them know you are approaching.

Pedestrians and **cyclists** could avoid getting hit by being more aware of their surroundings. Keep an eye out for vehicles and cyclists.
