October Board Meeting Speakers:

The Board and residents heard from two speakers who talked about insurance and plumbing issues.

Kevin Epperson, Complete Service Plumbing. Gave us insight as to why our water mains have been failing recently.

Age is the primary issue as well as the installation of thin-walled PVC material when the community was first developed.

Kevin noted that some of these breakdowns could be avoided by not parking on sidewalks. The heavy weight of vehicles puts pressure on underground pipes causing them to break.

At a previous board meeting it was brought up that there are isolation valves on each street.

Kevin also addressed this issue. He basically stated that they haven't been used in decades and most likely would fail if touched. Causing a huge financial issue to replace them.

Robert Mitchell, from Robert Mitchell Insurance told us why our insurance rates are so high.

The age of our roofs in our community is what has caused our rates to skyrocket.

Aside from that, many insurance companies are either pulling out of Florida or going under due to the high fraudulent claims and their own reinsurance rates skyrocketing. Fewer insurers = less competition = higher premiums for us.
