At this time last year I was basically the last man standing from the previous board. Little did I know the chaos that was left for us to contend with. The previous administration left a trail of missteps and bad decisions that created a domino effect. The decision to get the roofs inspected proved detrimental when finished. With that roof report in hand, our insurance agent quit, and our insurance company dropped us. When we took office last year, we were all stunned at what was left for us to contend with.

First, a brand-new insurance agent we did not know and finding out the insurance cost was over \$700,000! When it came time to sign the document, our lawyer did not show up for the meeting. (We have hired a new lawyer, Richard Zacur. My hand was shaking as I signed the document. In the back of my mind, thoughts were racing on how to pay for this.

We are talking 81 roofs that needed to be replaced, at the residents' expense and a special assessment that all of us had to pay.

When Jennifer Hanks took this on as the point man for the roof project, little did she know the amount of work that it would take to get this done. I applaud her for her tenacity and drive. We are almost there. Big, big thanks to Jennifer.

The problems with the sewers and the water mains continued. 50-year-old cast iron pipes are failing. Water mains also caused problems this year. Thank you, Richard Bennett, for your help on this. We have the maps of the water pipes, so we can get a bid for replacement. A big undertaking. The sewers are another problem.

We do not have a complete sewer map of our community. I have been to the city and county offices. I had them send me everything they had, and no complete map of our sewers was sent. Also, when the manholes got covered during the street asphalting in the past, it makes it impossible to track the sewers. We are not scheduled for relining the next set of sewers for two more years. I was also told by the In-lining company that they can't give a bid for it without the map. Do we spend the money to have our sewers mapped so we can move forward with options for replacing? It can be expensive. That's a question I'll leave for the next board to consider. Community interaction was the focus for Connie Mowrey and Mary Young this year. The Safety awareness and Hurricane seminars were well attended.

The social functions like Friendsgiving, Christmas, the Night of Wine, and Music, etc. that have brought so many people back together again. They were all fun events and good times were held by all. (Big thanks for all who donated to Toys for Tots, the children appreciate your generosity!)

The safety of our community was key for the the installation of the AEDs in the Clubhouse and the pool area. The 911 alert system was also installed along with the AED's. The clubhouse address is now posted throughout the complex. Thank you Linda and Art D'Elia for taking on that project.

The bird deterrents installed on the pool fence has proved an excellent investment. The birds have stayed away. Speaking of the pool, plans for night swimming are in the final steps and a long-term pool repair project has been set in motion starting in 2024. The front entrance was updated with a new bulletin board and new planting of the flower beds. The pavers and plants were all donated by residents. The clubhouse driveway is scheduled for resurfacing, eliminating the low spots and pooling and an addition of a ramp added to the door at entrance. Caution pole placed on Magnolia and Azalea seems to be working, trucks are not cutting the corner anymore.

The shuffleboard courts were refurbished this year and the lighting desperately needed attention being rusted and broken. With these projects being completed, in conjunction of the cleaning of the stage area, the piano being tuned and playable, and the donation of the new Pool Table (Thank you Tony Evans), the clubhouse is in good shape. Big thank you to the Hurricane Committee and all the volunteers for the incredible response to Ian.
