Next Board Meeting: Tuesday, April 23, 2024, at 7:00 pm *President's Message:*

This year we changed our agent of record for the association's insurance from Robert Mitchell Insurance Services to Franklin Hamilton Insurance. In doing so the association saved a little over \$200,000.00 on our insurance premium. We have a 5% windstorm deductible per occurrence/per building based on the appraisal value. For all other Perils we have a \$50,000.00 deductible per occurrence. The 2024 budget factored for all lines of insurance at \$817,600.00 and the new premium with finance charges, stamp tax and premium came to \$612,953.44.

After all HOA fees are collected and we don't have any insurance claims to pay out, the board will decide on how best to use the surplus. As we get closer to the end of the year, and we have a good idea on what next year's insurance premium will be and we will have a better idea of the amount of surplus and how best to use it.

Currently we have an insurance line item under the deferred maintenance reserve to be used for insurance deductibles. We put the monies collected from the door fee we got with the new Spectrum contract in this fund. That amount is around \$51,000.00. We need to build this fund up and possibly a good place to put the surplus we are collecting from the 2024 budget in this fund.

Cookin with Kenn German Potato Soup

Makes 8 servings. (Ideal for a 4-quart slow cooker)

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 onion, chopped.
- 1 leek trimmed and diced.
- 2 carrots, diced.
- 1 cup chopped cabbage.
- ¼ cup fresh chopped parsley
- 4 cups of beef broth
- 1 lb. potatoes, diced.
- 1 bay leaf
- 1-2 tsp. black pepper
- 1 tsp. salt
- ½ tsp. caraway seeds
- ¼ tsp. nutmeg
- ½ lb. bacon, cooked and crumbled
- ½ cup sour cream

DIRECTIONS:

Combine all ingredients except bacon and sour cream. Cover. Cook on low 8-10 hours or high 4-5 hours.

Remove bay leaf. Use a slotted spoon to remove potatoes. Mash potatoes and mix with sour cream. Return to slow cooker. Stir in. Add bacon and mix thoroughly.
