Question: What are my voting rights in the condominium association?

Question: What restrictions exist in the Condominium Documents on my rights to use my unit?

Answer: The Condominium Documents, and any amendments define the various restrictions.

Question: What restrictions exist in the Condominium Documents on the leasing of my unit?

Answer: Every lease and lease renewal of a unit must receive advance written approval by the

Board of Directors. Tenants are required to fill out an Association Application, background check authorization, pay the required administration fee, and submit a copy of the lease or

rental agreement.

Question: How much are my assessments to the Condominium Association for my unit and when are

they due?

Answer: The amount of the assessment for each unit can be determined by reviewing the current

Question: Am I required to pay rent or land use fees for recreational or other commonly used

facilities? If so, how much am I obligated to pay?

Answer: No, there are no land leases or recreational leases.

Question: Is the Condominium Association or other mandatory member association involved in any

court cases in which they may face liability in excess of \$100,000.00?

Answer: There are no legal actions regarding liability limits in excess of \$100,000.00
