President's Message:

Here comes the fence!

We witnessed a wonderful show of community involvement as 120 owners voted on the issue of installing white vinyl fencing. A yes-vote was expressed by 110 of those owners. Next steps include completing property surveys as required by the City of Pinellas Park, clearing the overgrown shrubbery and plants along the proposed fence lines and establishing the installation dates. Our neighbors on 56th Street have been very cooperative and as soon as we have the installation date, we will advise our neighbors. They will then complete the clearing of the areas abutting their property.

The new white vinyl fencing will be installed behind Palm Crest; along Hyacinth and behind Rosewood.

If your unit backs along these areas and you have garden ornaments please remove for the installation and if you have plants or bushes, please trim back for the installation. Florida Groundskeepers have been contracted to clear these areas, but you have an opportunity to trim plants that you care about. The villa painting project continues to move forward, and the villa painting committee has been working diligently to gain cooperation and consensus on color selections. We hope to see some freshly painted villas in February.

Just a reminder to all that our community swimming pool is open for swimming from dawn to dusk, only. Please respect our rules and for your own safety do not swim after dusk or before dawn. The holiday season is in full swing. My thanks to each volunteer who ensure our holiday social events are magical! While I will enjoy a white Christmas up in Canada, I wish everyone a warm, happy Christmas and a peace filled New Year.
