## **President's Message:**

### **Changes**

I welcome back all our returning snowbirds. It is wonderful to see you again and to have the opportunity of enjoying your company. I hope you will enjoy some of the changes and improvements that have been made to our community over the summer months. In the past couple of weeks, the sewer relining project was completed, and the palm trees trimmed.

One change that is underway will require a community vote. It is to have white vinyl fencing installed along Hyacinth; and behind Palm Crest; and behind Rosewood. A vendor has been selected by the Board and the funds to pay for the fence is in our reserve funding. You will not be asked for any additional funding for this project. The white vinyl fence will replace aging, rusty chain link fencing and will improve the appearance and privacy for our Association. Our neighbors on 56Th Street have already, in anticipation, begun preparing for the new fencing. Several of the neighbors have removed their section of the rusty chain link fence and trimmed back overgrown bushes, plants and trees. I strongly urge you to vote yes for the white vinyl fence. The proxy voting forms and letters have been mailed to all owners and the vote will take place at a membership meeting on Tuesday November 13 at 7 p.m. in the auditorium.

I am saddened to announce that two Board members have recently resigned; Art D'Elia and Becky Goss. I take this opportunity to thank both Art and Becky for their contribution to our Association. We will work as a five-member Board of Directors until the Annual Membership Meeting in February. The position of Vice President, held by Art D'Elia, will remain vacant until the 2019 Board is installed during the Annual Membership meeting.
