## **President's Message:**

Here is an update of what's happening in our community:

- 1) Lowe's has begun painting the villas.
- 2) We are working closely with our legal team on a resolution with the apartment owners.
- 3) We are getting estimates for the replacement of the Clubhouse roof.
- 4) The fence is close to being completed.
- 5) We are evaluating issues with the sidewalks. If anyone has any suggestions or complaints, please contact Board Director Tom Planavsky.
- 6) Within the next couple of weeks, our janitor will be stripping and refinishing the floors in the meeting room and the kitchen. We cannot use these rooms for 48 hours and access to the Clubhouse from the parking lot will not be possible for 48 hours. Once I know the exact dates, I will notify the Block Captains to pass this information on to you.
- 7) We will be getting estimates to get duct work cleaned in the Clubhouse.
- 8) The fountain has been approved; we are just waiting for estimates on electrical work. It should also help with mosquito control during the rainy season.
- 9) A rumor has been going around that we are going to install water meters. That is not true.
- 10) Please be aware of unfamiliar vehicles in your area during the night. Outdoor figurines were stolen from a house on Larchmont Place.
- 11) I would like to thank the Passamontes for cleaning up the bushes on the side of the Clubhouse.
