#### **INGREDIENTS:**

- 3 large beets
- 1 tablespoon olive oil •
- 1 pinch salt •
- 2 tablespoon honey •

#### DIRECTIONS:

Preheat the oven to 375 degrees. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper. Cut the stems and leaves from beets and wash well. With skin on, cut beets into chunks. Toss beets in olive oil and sprinkle with salt. Spread beets in an even layer on the prepared

baking sheet.

Roast in the preheated oven for 30 min. Remove from the oven and drizzle with Honey. Using a wooden spoon, stir beets to coat completely with honey, then spread them back out on the pan. Continue roasting until tender, about 15 minutes. Allow to cool.

# German Potato Soup

Makes 8 servings.

#### **INGREDIENTS:**

- 1 onion, chopped. •
- 1 leek trimmed and diced. •
- 2 carrots, diced. •
- 1 cup chopped cabbage.
- <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cup fresh chopped parsley •
- 4 cups of beef broth •
- 1 lb. potatoes, diced. •
- 1 bay leaf
- 1-2 tsp. black pepper ٠
- 1 tsp. salt •
- <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> tsp. caraway seeds •
- ٠ ¼ tsp. nutmeg
- 1/2 lb. bacon, cooked and crumbled •
- ½ cup sour cream •

#### **DIRECTIONS:**

Combine all ingredients except bacon and sour cream.

Using a slow cooker, cover and cook on low 8 to 10 hours or 4 to 5 hours on high.

Remove bay leaf. Use a slotted spoon to remove potatoes. Mash potatoes and mix with sour cream. Return to slow cooker. Stir in. Add bacon and mix thoroughly.
