From the Editor:

The board of directors is seeking your help in changing our "Declaration of Condominium" from the 146 affirmative votes (two-thirds of the voting membership) presently required, down to 119 affirmative votes (54 percent of the voting membership).

For the above referendum to pass, we need to follow our present Declaration of Condominium guidelines of 146 affirmative votes.

This referendum needs to pass so that our community doesn't stay complacent on proposed future issues that are put before the community for approval.

Some reasons for needing a community vote may simply be due to making a material or color change, or an improvement that didn't exist before. If the referendum doesn't get the required two-thirds of the memberships' approval, nothing happens. The referendum is dead in the water and must be either dropped or another mailing must occur to try and get more votes. When this happens, a lot of time (usually months) and community funds are wasted.

This situation could be avoided if our owners vote "yes" to lower the number of affirmative votes needed to pass from 146 down to 119.

Some owners may have the mindset that their vote doesn't count because the powers that be will do what they want. Your vote could make the difference between an issue passing or failing. If you want to vote, but don't know much about the referendum, ask a director or neighbor for some help gathering the information you need to make a good decision.

It is your responsibility to help Springwood II succeed by submitting your votes either by mail, in person or by proxy. Your vote "for" or "against" either way is important, as it gives a true consensus on the how the community wants to proceed on the issues that are put before them.

As owners we put our faith and trust into our board of directors, the board in turn is putting their faith and trust into Springwood II owners by expecting them to at the very least participate when it comes to voting on important community issues.

If you don't plan on attending the upcoming special meeting, PLEASE take the time to fill out the proxy and return it by mail or just drop it off in the clubhouse office mail slot.
