Let's follow the Golden Rule and bring peace to our little world here. Here is what has been happening in our little world this past month that has been keeping me busy. Thank you for your patience.

FENCE- Board voted for Freedom Fence. Check & signed contract mailed. Install still expected in approximately 5-6 weeks.

BRUSH/TREES – Fallen trees removed, brush picked up, grinding of stumps/roots almost done. Requested an Arborist for health a health analysis on the trees to ensure safety of surrounding buildings/fence areas- Report pending.

WASHING MACHINE - met with Freedom Appliance, awaiting part for install. Expected repair before end of November.

POOL RENO - went to Pool Works & saw coping and tile selections. Confirmed scheduled to begin in February.

WATER LEAK ON AZALEA - Kevin repaired leak on Tuesday 11/19. Water was shut off from 9-1 that day.

POOL CHEM ROOM DOORS - met with Samet, a handy man from Ameritech. Waiting on the quote.

CHEM ROOM EXHAUST FAN - Waiting on Electrician to get quote. This fan repair could give additional options for the doors' replacement.

CLUBHOUSE DRIVEWAY LAMP POST - Have 1 quote for approximately \$600. Waiting on additional electrician through James.

POOL FENCE - repair requested, needs to be stretched and new cord installed. On 5-to 6 weeks wait list due to demand from hurricane.

UNIT OWNER REPAIRS - In process. Awaiting receipts/quotes and insurance agent's assessment on coverage. Still need determination of responsibility on each item. Reaching out to our insurance agents again for status update. Need more clarification on the policy coverage.

ROOF CLEANING - Had James find companies that meet off roof requirement, they submitted quote. Pending update on handling those with solar panels.

SHUFFLEBOARD ROOF REPAIR – getting quote to replace fascia and soffit on roof exposed to weather – James getting quote

POOL SOUND SYSTEM - In process of repair by Mark K.

CHRISTMAS DECORATION AT CLUBHOUSE - Dave working on getting the Christmas nativity ready. He will need assistance to move it and setup.

WEBSITE -PRIVATE SIDE - sent request to fix errors found on website.

POOL HEATERS – Repair of heater. Temp. holding at 82 degrees until heater is repaired.

SPRINGWOOD VILLAS FRONTAGE SIGN – Addressing possible damage from storm. Cracks are visible.

MAP SIGNAGE – Reached out for status of delivery, awaiting answer.

WATER DRAINAGE ISSUES – Reached out to Pinellas Park City Hall on flooded streets, pending review Also, review needed by board on engineer's report on yard swamping areas in community

FINANCIALS - worked on budget to ensure monthly fees to remain exactly as they are now.
