#### HURRICANE SEASON IS ALMOST HERE:

# Below are some helpful tips to help you prepare for hurricane season:

• If you need to evacuate to a shelter, have a plan in place. Make sure the facility you are going to can accommodate your medical needs.

- If you have a pet, find out if that facility accommodates pets. Or if you are going to a hotel / motel, made sure they allow pets.
- If the hotel is local, find out what evacuation zone they are in. A good example is the LaQuinta across from us. They are in evacuation zone "C". If evacuation zone "C" is ordered, they will have no choice but to make you leave.
- Don't wait until the last couple of days before a storm to stock up on canned goods, water, batteries, paper plates, and pet supplies.
- Refill water bottles and put them in your freezer. This will help keep your food cold should there be a power failure.

#### Seasonal Residents:

**Before** you leave, bring all objects inside that could become airborne. Make sure your emergency contact information is up to date.

#### Year-round Residents:

Should we get to the Hurricane Watch stage, start to take in all furniture and lawn ornaments that could become airborne in a windstorm.

#### Hurricane Preparedness Committee:

We have a hurricane committee available to assist residents that may need help moving their things inside.

Presently we have 4 volunteers on the committee; Kevin O'Brian, Mary Young, Phyllis Sava or Jennifer Hanks.
