From the President:

By now, you should have received the proxy that was mailed to you in August. Please do not discard this proxy as this is a very important issue. The board is "FOR" passing this referendum. However, your vote, either way is very important as it will give a true consensus on how owners want their community to move forward.

Informational Meeting:

Tuesday, September 10, 2024, at 1:00 p.m.

The board is having an informational meeting on Tuesday, September 10, 2024, to help owners understand the referendum, and how to fill out their proxy.

At this meeting you will be able to submit your completed and signed proxy to the secretary of the board or our property manager.

Adopt-a-Drain:

The board is looking for volunteers to take on the responsibility of keeping an assigned storm drain unobstructed and clear of debris.

This is not a difficult task when several residents pitch in to keep the storm drains near their unit clear of debris.

Volunteers will be helping their community by ensuring that storm water runs off as quick as possible.

Complaints, Concerns and Suggestions:

Going forward, residents are requested to submit all complaints, concerns and suggestions directly to the management company.

The management company will make a record of your request and then forward it to the Board for further action.

By following this procedure, your request will be on record, and it will be investigated by the management company and/or the board.

During the last power outage, I was overwhelmed with calls from residents who wanted to know when the power was coming back on.

As soon as your power goes out, call the Duke Energy Power Outage line 800-228-8485 to report your power outage, they will tell you how widespread the power failure is and give you an approximate time the power will come back on, plus send you updates on the progress of the repair.



The Water Runneth Over:

Tropical storm Debbie dumped a lot of water in our area in a short period of time. Like the movie

"The Perfect Storm" several factors came together to cause our streets to flood, the duration and amount of rain along with high tide.

Pinellas County Utilities was not able to process the amount of storm water they were receiving fast enough.

The last time it was this bad in our community was about 20 years ago. Springwood Blvd. was under water. As always, Rosewood Court got the most amount of rising water. Thankfully, the water recedes within several hours.

Storing Sandbags:

Proper Disposal of Sandbags:

Once the hurricane season is over you need to store them in a dry area, or you can use the sand to fill in some low spots and/or evenly spread the sand over your lawn and rake it in.

Quick Dams:

Are available at Home Depot or online at Amazon. They come in various lengths to accommodate the areas you want to protect.

At Home Depot you can purchase two 5-foot long by 3.5 inches high sections for \$25.00.

As with sandbags it is recommended to put down plastic sheeting or a tarp.

Quick Dams are reusable for the next hurricane season. Just lay them out straight in a dry area and let them dry out for approximately 2 months.

The volunteers are available to help physically challenged residents move their lawn furniture and ornaments to a safe place.
