Raisin Nut-Stuffed Apples:

Makes 6 servings

(Ideal slow cooker size: 4-quart)

INGREDIENTS:

- 6 medium baking apples, cored
- 1 ½ Tbsp. soft margarine melted
- 2 Tbsp. Packed brown sugar
- ¾ cup raisins
- 3 Tbsp. chopped walnuts
- ½ cup water

DIRECTIONS:

Peel a strip around each apple about one-third of the way below the stem end to prevent splitting.

Mix margarine, brown sugar. Stir in raisins and walnuts. Stuff into apple cavities.

Place apples in slow cooker. Add water.

Cover and cook on low 6-8 hours.

German Potato Soup:

Makes 8 servings

(Ideal slow cooker size: 4-quart)

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 onion, chopped
- 1 leek, trimmed and diced
- 2 carrots, diced
- 1 cup chopped cabbage
- ¼ cup fresh chopped parsley
- 4 cups of beef broth
- 1 lb. potatoes, diced
- 1 bay leaf
- 1-2 tsp. black pepper
- 1 tsp. salt
- ½ tsp. caraway seeds
- ¼ tsp. nutmeg
- ½ lb. bacon, cooked and crumbled
- ½ cup sour cream

DIRECTIONS:

Combine all ingredients except bacon and sour cream. Cover.

Cook on low 8-10 hours or high 4-5 hours.

Remove bay leaf. Use a slotted spoon to remove potatoes. Mash potatoes and mix with sour cream.

Return to slow cooker. Stir in. Add

bacon and mix thoroughly.
