Tomese Meatloaf:



INGREDIENTS:

- 1 pound ground beef
- 1 pound ground pork
- 1½ cups quick cooking oatmeal
- 1 cup milk
- 1 egg, beaten.
- ¼ cup minced onion
- 1 teaspoon salt
- ½ teaspoon fresh ground black pepper
- ½ teaspoon celery salt
- ½ teaspoon dry mustard
- ½ teaspoon dry sage
- 1 tablespoon Dijon mustard
- 1 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce
- ½ cup ketchup, chili sauce or barbecue sauce

DIRECTIONS:

Mix all ingredients (except ketchup) thoroughly. Place in a 9x5 inch loaf pan and smooth out the top. Spread a thick layer of ketchup or other over the top.

Bake in a 350 oven for 1-1 ½ hours, until there is a nice slightly burnt edge all around.

Serves 8 for dinner, or fewer if you want leftovers for sandwiches.
