Phase III Extreme Water Shortage

Watering Guidelines:

As of April 17, 2026, Pinellas County has implemented strict "Modified Phase III Extreme Water Shortage" restrictions, requiring **one-day-a-week** lawn watering between 12:01 a.m. to 8 a.m. or 6 p.m. to 11:59 p.m.

Pinellas County Watering Schedule: (based on address)

Addresses Ending in Even Numbers: **Tuesdays**

Addresses Ending in Odd Numbers: **Thursdays**

Key Rules:

Hours: 12:01 a.m. – 8 a.m. or 6 p.m. – 11:59 p.m.

No Watering: Do not water during or immediately after rain.

Key Rules for Watering Plants and Landscapes:

Hand Watering / Micro Irrigation: Allowed any day, but restricted to hours before 8 a.m. or after 6 p.m.

New Plants / Landscapes: 60-day establishment period is allowed but must follow strict guidelines.

Prohibited: No hosing down driveways or buildings.

Compliance: Fines are active, replacing warnings as of April 17, 2026. Violations are subject to \$193 citations.

These rules apply to all water sources (potable, well, lake) for all residents.

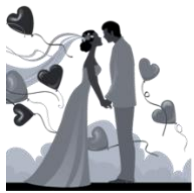
Dale did an exceptional job barbecuing the hot dogs and cheeseburgers. Approx. 80 attended.

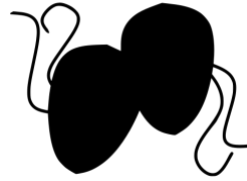
